APPLY

a) Do you think you would have responded to Jesus like Nicodemus did? Why or why not?

b) In his sermon, Matt Ryman said that Nicodemus responded to Jesus out of both pride and fear. What is a way that you have responded in either fear or pride to Jesus (either recently or in the past)? How does Jesus address your fears and pride?

c) What are your reactions to Jesus' statement that "unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God"?

d) How do those words of Jesus give you hope today?

e) Do Jesus' words in verses 16-21 give you a sense of security? Why or why not?
